Registration Guidelines

The application must be completed and sent to Marc Mallet, Summer School Director. Tuition is \$800 per semester course (Urban Experience requires additional spending money for lunch). The tuition for Photography, Painting, and Drawing on Location in Historic Savannah is \$2,100 (all included). Each semester course carries 0.5 Carnegie Units of credit (except as noted). Classes fill quickly and space is limited. Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis. Full refunds of tuition will be made in the event that a class is cancelled by Lovett. In the event a student withdraws four weeks prior to the start date, a tuition refund will be made, minus the \$100 processing fee. If a student withdraws fewer than two weeks prior to the start date, no tuition refund will be made. Upon registration, **if you are a Lovett student, your account will be billed in full** (\$800). This includes the \$100 non-refundable processing fee. If you are not a Lovett student, please send the application with a check for the full tuition (\$800). Make the check payable to the Lovett School. The student's name should be indicated on the check. In case of withdrawal due to illness, the family and the school will share the loss equally. Written notice from a physician will be required before the refund is issued. No reduction can be made for late entry, early departure, or withdrawal for any reason other than cited above unless previously requested in writing and approved by Marc Mallet, the Summer School Director. Course descriptions are available by following the summer school link at www.lovett.org, in The Lovett Summer Program catalog, or from the Summer School Director. Classes are open to rising ninth through twelfth-grade students (except as noted), and students from other schools are welcome. If a student wishes to take a summer school course at another institution for Lovett credit, the student must submit a written request to the Academic Dean. The request must be approved by the Academic Dean prior to enrollment in that summer school course.

Summer School Rules

- **Dress:** The dress for summer school is casual. Shorts and sandals are ok, but bare feet are not. Students taking Urban Experience or Photography, painting, and Drawing on Location in Historic Savannah will receive instructions on appropriate attire from their teacher.
- **Attendance:** In case of illness, please call Mr. Mallet by 8:30 a.m. (404) 262-3032, ext. 1467. The student must bring a signed note from his/her parent the day following the absence. Having more than one absence will result in withholding credit for a course. If there is an emergency situation parents must contact the Summer School Director. If a student has more than five late arrivals, the student is in jeopardy of not receiving credit for the course. A late arrival is defined as arriving to class after 8:10 a.m. **An absence on the first or last day of the semester counts as two absences.** Summer school is very concentrated and being absent one day is the equivalent of missing over a week of the regular school year. Every effort should be made to be present and on time. Doctor's appointments must be scheduled after school hours. See the Lovett Parent/Student Handbook for school policy on attendance.
- **Make-up Work:** Make-up work is the student's responsibility. The student should consult class syllabi, classmates or the teacher for assignments. If the absence occurs on the day of a scheduled test or quiz or the due date of a written assignment, the student completes that work on the day of return. If the absence occurs the day before the test, the student must take the test as scheduled.
- **Closed Campus:** **Once a student has arrived on campus, he/she may not leave campus until dismissed by the teacher.**
- **Field Trips:** Students must turn in permission forms, signed by their parent, to leave campus for field trips.

Note: The Lovett School reserves the right to cancel a course if there is insufficient student enrollment or insufficient faculty availability. Full tuition will be refunded if a course is cancelled or if a student withdraws 30 days prior to the course beginning. Students withdrawing after that time will receive a partial refund.
