Summer School Rules

- **Dress:** The dress for summer school is casual. Shorts and sandals are ok, but bare feet are not.
- **Attendance (make up credit course):** In case of illness, please call Mr. Mallet by 8:30 a.m. (404) 262-3032, ext. 1467. The student must bring a signed note from his/her parent the day following the absence. If there is an emergency situation, parents must contact the Summer School Director. Because summer school is very concentrated, an absence of one day is significant. Therefore, every effort should be made to be present and on time. Doctor's appointments must be scheduled after school hours.
- **Make-up Work:** Make-up work is the student's responsibility. The student should consult class syllabi, classmates, or the teacher for assignments. If the absence occurs on the day of a scheduled test or quiz or the due date of a written assignment, the student completes that work on the day of return. If the absence occurs the day before the test, the student must take the test as scheduled.
- **Closed Campus: Once a student has arrived on campus, he/she may not leave campus until dismissed by the teacher.**
- **Field Trips:** Students must turn in permission forms, signed by their parents, to leave campus for field trips.
